



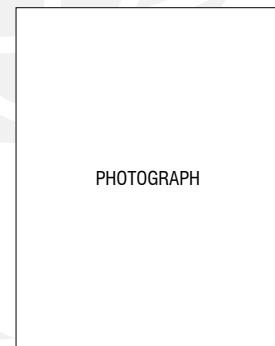

Summer: 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM Winter: 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM
- Grade 1 onwards:
Summer: 8:00 AM - 2:00 PM Winter: 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM

The departure is 10 minutes after the end time of school.

School gate will be closed after 8.10 AM during the summers and 9.10 AM during the winters. Those students who will report to school late beyond the stipulated time given above will not be allowed to enter the school premises. After two late responses, the parents will be called to school.

School Office Timings:-

Summer: 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Winter: 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

Day Boarding programme begins after regular school time and would be of 2 to 3 hours duration.

Time schedule for boarders is provided in the Boarder's Handbook

Meeting with the Principal or the Vice Principal/Academic Coordinator/Primary Coordinator/Incharge during school hours may be scheduled with prior appointment.

ATTENDANCE

Punctuality and regular attendance is imperative for successful implementation of the academic programme. It is mandatory to have minimum 90% attendance. Hence :

- Leaves are granted only in case of emergencies. Leave application, **addressed to the Principal**, should reach the grade teacher a day before. In unavoidable circumstances, the application can be sent on the next day.
- The application should be signed by the parent or the guardian.
- Leave on medical grounds should be supported by an authentic medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner, all the reports taken and prescription of medicines given.
- Students suffering from infectious disease should not be attending classes.
- The attendance for the year should not be less than 90% of the total working days (for transfer cases, the attendance from previous school will be taken into consideration). Students failing to maintain this attendance would not be allowed to sit for the final examination, may not be promoted to the next grade.
- Absence from school for twenty consecutive days (without approved leave) will result in removal of the student's name from the rolls. The student will have to apply for re-admission thereafter.
- Grade 10th and 12th students require minimum 90% cumulative attendance from Grade 9 and 11 respectively in order to sit for the board examination.

UNIFORM

- All students must wear only the prescribed uniform on all weekdays without making any alterations. Uniforms should always be clean.
- Coloured dress is allowed only on birthdays and when announced by the school.
- Nails of children would be checked on regular basis. They should be properly trimmed and kept clean.
- Tattoos, bangles, goggles, fancy pins, mehendi or any other form of dye are not allowed in school.
- No expensive accessories should be worn in the school.
- All boys must keep their hair short. Girls must tie their hair neatly with a band. Only black turban and black bands are to be used.
- If prescribed uniform is not worn by students, they may be penalised as per policy.
- Repeated offenders (more than 3 times in a month) will be sent back home. Parents will have to make their own arrangements.

COURSE BOOKS DISTRIBUTIONS

All students are directed that the lockers are given to them to keep their books in the school itself. Only test/homework related books and copies should be taken home. No student is allowed to take all the books and copies in bag which weighs more than 3 kg at any point of time.

LIBRARY/MEDIA CENTRE

The library is open during school hours. All borrowed items will be the responsibility of the user. Personal/additional reading, study sessions and facilities for the preparation of research project will be made available to the students on request. Any loss / damage of any library resource will have to be paid by the user. Only two books at a time will be issued for a time period of 15 days. A fine of Rs. 100/- per week will be charged for late return of books/ CD's/DVD's.

VISITORS

Visitors are not permitted on the campus during the school hours. However, in exceptional cases, permission may be granted. Parents are welcome to visit the campus on Fridays between 10:00 a.m to 12.00 noon with prior permission from the Principal/Vice Principal/Admin Office. The authority who has given the permission will inform the reception about that particular person's details.

SCHOOL LOCKERS

Lockers are assigned to each student by the grade teachers so that students can keep their things safely. Hence responsibility for the loss of personal property lies with the student. School will not compensate for any such losses. Students who cause damage to their lockers will be charged. Any mechanical problem with the lockers should be reported to the teachers/respective Coordinators.

IDENTIFICATION CARDS

All students are provided ID cards which are to be worn when attending school and at any school programmes within or outside the campus. In case of loss or damage to the ID card, a new card would be issued at a cost of INR. 150. This is a **Mandatory** requirement for all the students.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus services are made available to the students. It is an optional facility provided by the school. The management will take all necessary precautions for the safety of the children availing the school transport but shall not be responsible for any unforeseen event.

The students are to be picked up by an authorized person carrying the necessary identification. In the absence of this, the child will be taken back to school. Parents are requested to take full responsibility for the collection of their child from the designated stop. In case of non payment of bus or school fees the conveyance facilities may be discontinued by the school at any time. Due to traffic or any other condition, the bus may be late which the parents can check through GPS App or contact school. Please note that the school reserves the right to re-route or withdraw bus services at its discretion.

Students are expected to remain seated on their seats while the bus is moving. Repeated misbehaviour or any act which may endanger lives or lead to damage to the vehicle will result in suspension of the bus service for that student. Clear rules are laid out for bus travel for the students. These are to be adhered to strictly to ensure safety all round.

SCHOOL INFIRMARY

When taking medication during school hours, the following requirements will have to be met

- The medical card of the child is mandatory to be deposited at school failing which the school may not be able to administer medicine in case of emergency to the child.
- The medicine must be prescribed by a registered physician.
- Parents must submit a written permission for such medication. Copy of the doctor's prescription should be attached.

If a student is unwell during the day, he/she may take a pass from the subject or grade teacher to go to the infirmary. The pass is to be returned to the teacher on return to class. The nurse records the visit of the student in the infirmary register. School must be informed of any allergies that a child may have.

A prolonged stay at the infirmary without prior permission amounts to truancy. If medical condition warrants (high fever, severe stomach ache, etc.) the parents would be asked to take their child home.

Students are administered basic first aid for common ailments and minor injuries. In case of any unforeseen emergency, the initial aid/support is provided as per the need and the parents of the concerned child will be informed immediately. The student will be taken to the hospital.

Students are usually up-to date on their immunization until they reach the age of 14. Please be sure to update their immunization records and provide the school with a copy. Allergies, if any, need to be intimated to the school.

Routine medical check-up of students are conducted through out the year by the school nurse.

The doctor makes regular visits to school.

STUDENT SERVICES - COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE

Our Counselling and Guidance Services stress the individual uniqueness of students and is based on the belief that all students should be directed to a level of self-actualization. The scope of the services is preventive and proactive in focus and developmental in content and process. 'Developmental Counselling' and 'Crisis Intervention' are the two main components of the services.

The Guidance and Counselling Cell anticipates the challenges in the students' lives and assists them in gaining maturity. The underlying focus of the programme is to help students develop the skill, attitude and knowledge base they need for the success of their academic and personal endeavours.

Special support is provided to students who may experience learning difficulties so that their special educational needs (within the limits of mild and the moderate zone) are met.

At least 2 workshops on 'adolescence' are conducted for the students by paediatric experts to enable students to deal with their own physiological growth.

All teachers at ITM Global School are given basic primary training for the counselling and guidance.

BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT

Behaviour management techniques usually include encouragement, praise and positive reinforcement. Opportunities are provided to a student to gain self-control and reliance and to respond positively to others in a social setting. Acceptable and proper behaviour is described through stories so that students associate themselves with the characters and thus understand that their behaviour needs to improve. This does not destroy self-esteem and promotes acceptable social interaction with peers as well as adults. A positive proactive approach which includes prevention, redirection and praise is the preferred intervention model. Various financial penalties are also in place if the child does not respond to the above methods. The concept of community service is also in place in the school for students who continue to be in the defaulters list. Temporary suspension from school will be imposed on regular defaulters (more than 3 times) in case of a very serious misconduct, this may lead to rustication after proper enquiry is constituted.

PREFERRED CODE OF CONDUCT

Any damage seen or done should be reported promptly to the grade Teacher/Incharges/respective Coordinator/Vice Principal or the Principal immediately.

7. Students are advised not to carry valuables to the school.
8. Each student should take responsibility of his/her own belongings.

HOW TO LEARN EFFICIENTLY

Today, everybody is a student. The expansion and updating of knowledge makes all of us life-long learners. Here are few tips for studying more effectively.

1. **Keep yourself fit both physically and temperamentally.**
 - Get sufficient sleep. Most of us need about seven hours sleep.
 - Do vigorous exercise daily for at least an hour.
 - Take time daily to do something that you genuinely enjoy such as painting, working with tools, music, poetry etc.
2. **Have a regular place for studying**
 - Fix up a study table for yourself. Use a chair with a straight backrest. Only keep items which are being used on the table to avoid unnecessary overcrowding of table top.
 - For light reading, you could use another chair placed in a quiet place.
3. **Work out a time-schedule and follow it.**
4. **Increase motivation by recalling your goals.**
 - Set up goals for yourselves to drive your efforts.
 - Remind yourselves continually to achieve your short term goals keeping the long term goals at the back of your mind.

Your learning will not be substantial if your goals are not clear.

We discourage the concept of extra tuition at home as it confuses the child even more because the teaching methodology at school is different, better and in sync with latest pedagogies.

HOW TO ORGANIZE YOUR TIME FOR LEARNING

If you can learn to manage your time, you acquire lifelong managerial skill. There are four key points in time management.

1. **Right Size of Time Unit:**

Work psychologists tell us that people get their best work done by working intensively for a reasonable period of time, then resting or switching over to something else. Shovelling sand might mean 15 minutes of work and then a pause. Managers might use 90 minute units in their schedules. For study 60 minutes seems to be a good unit.
2. **Right Amount of Time:**
 - a. Recall your goals and abilities, and decide how much time you wish to assign to each activity.
 - b. If you are a student, 24 hours of study a week is probably more than enough to achieve your academic goals. Increasing study time to 35 or 40 hours does not guarantee better results. In most cases, the opposite may happen
 - c. The pay off in studying requires concentration and interest.
3. **Right Distribution of Time Units:**
 - a. Spread out your subjects strategically. Generally, six single hours on consecutive days are better than six consecutive hours on the same day.
 - b. Do assigned reading just before the class.
4. **Right Sequence Order:**
 - a. Subjects like mathematics must be studied daily. Miss a point and you tend to lag behind
 - b. Study tough demanding subjects when you are at your most alert stage in the day.

 - Applicant's copy of fee slip

 - Marksheet and TC would be required when the student joins the school.

EXAMINATION POLICY

NEW ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 – 2021

Academic Session has been divided into two terms. First Term (from April to September) and Second Term (from October to March).

CAMBRIDGE AND CBSE GRADE NURSERY TO IV (ASSESSMENT) 2020-21

Pre-Primary Section will have Formative Assessments, no Unit Tests. Only Play Way method will be incorporated.

Grades I-IV will have Formative Assessments, no Unit Tests. Continuous Subject wise Assessments with Class Tests will be conducted in 2nd and 4th week of every month for which the schedule will be provided in advance.

SA-1 and SA-2 Exams will be conducted from Pre Primary to Grade IX, XI.

CAMBRIDGE GRADE V TO XII (ASSESSMENT) 2020-21

- **Grade V to VIII:** Grade V to VIII will have Four Formative Assessment (Including two Unit Tests) and two Summative Assessments.
- **Grade IX and XI:** Grade IX and XI will have two Unit Tests and two Summative Assessments.
- **Grade X and XII:** Grade X and XII will have two Unit Tests and two Pre boards.

Students appearing for the Board Examinations will have One Unit Test, One Semester Examination [Limited Syllabus] and Two Pre-Boards [Full Syllabus covered]. Any Grade 10 and 12 students not appearing for the Two Pre-Boards will not be allowed to appear for their forthcoming CBSE / CAMBRIDGE BOARD EXAMINATION.

No RE-EXAM will be conducted for any student under any circumstances. The child will be marked absent if he/she misses any Unit Tests, First Semester and Second Semester Examination. They will be marked ABSENT and no average will be considered. Only Medical cases will be considered wherein the child may get exempted to appear for the same and the AVERAGE will be considered. For this the following criteria's must be met:

- Medical Certificate must be produced from the Government Certified Medical Practitioner / Hospital with the registered ID.
- All the prescribed medicines and treatment prescriptions must be submitted.

CBSE GRADE V TO XII (ASSESSMENT) 2020-21

- **Grade V:** Grade V will have Four Formative Assessment (Including two Unit Tests) and two Summative Assessments.
- **Grade VI to VIII:** Grade VI to VIII will have Periodic Assessment 1 and Periodic Assessment 2 along with Half Yearly Examination and Annual Examination. The Academic structure for Classes IX-X is as per the Remodeled Structure of Assessment as per CBSE guidelines.
- **Grade IX:** Grade IX will have 3 Periodic Tests in Internal Assessment with Half Yearly Examination and Annual Examination.
- **Grade X:** Grade X will have 3 Periodic Tests in Internal Assessment with two Pre boards.
- **Grade XI:** There will be two Periodic Tests (PT1 and PT2) along with Half Yearly and Annual Examination.
- **Grade XII:** There will be two Periodic Tests (PT1 and PT2) along with two Pre Boards.

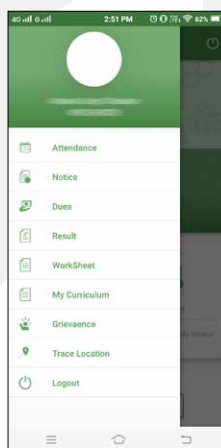
Login screen: To login, you need to enter his/her Roll number, password and then choose the Board of Education (i.e Cambridge/CBSE). Click on LOGIN button.

 - Keep the school informed about changes in contact numbers, addresses, etc.
 - Submit all student related documents for school/DEO Offices – SSSMID details, Address and ID proof, Adhar Card, Caste certificate (where applicable), etc.
 - Inform the school well in time of withdrawal of their children (at least a month in advance) due to transfers, relocations or any other reason. If a parent fails to do so then the next quarter fee will be charged as per the withdrawal policy of the School.
 - Keep in regular touch with school authorities so that even the smallest of concerns can be addressed in a timely manner.
 - Provide feedback, suggestions and inputs for school development.
 - Make the fee payments as per schedule to support school programmes and avoid any mutual inconvenience.
 - Parents must acknowledge the Almanac on daily basis.

Fees and late fee charges – School fees must be paid on time (in advance) as per schedule given below:

1st quarter fee – by 15th April 2nd quarter fee – by 10th August
3rd quarter fee – by 10th November 4th quarter fee – by 10th February

There would be late fee charges amounting upto 10% of the unpaid fee.

10% rebate is given when full fee is paid at one time before start of session or by 15th April. **For grade 10th and 12th fourth quarter fee must be paid latest by 30 January.**
