How to organise your time for Learning

If you can learn to manage your time, you acquire lifelong managerial skill. There are four key points in time management.

1. Right Size of Time Unit:

Work psychologists tell us that people get their best work done by working intensively for a reasonable period of time, then resting or switching over to something else. Shovelling sand might mean 15 minutes of work and then a pause. Managers might use 90 minute units in their schedules. For study 60 minutes seems to be a good unit.

2. Right Amount of Time:

- a. Recall your goals and abilities, and decide how much time you wish to assign to each activity.
- b. If you are a student, 24 hours of study a week is probably more than enough to achieve your academic goals. Increasing study time to 35 or 40 hours does not guarantee better results. In most cases, the opposite may happen
- c. The pay off in studying requires concentration and interest.

3. Right Distribution of Time Units:

- a. Spread out your subjects strategically. Generally, six single hours on consecutive days are better than six consecutive hours on the same day.
- b. Do assigned reading just before the class.

4. Right Sequence Order:

- a. Subjects like mathematics must be studied daily. Miss a point and you tend to lag behind
- b. Study tough demanding subjects when you are at your most alert stage in the day.

COURSE BOOKS DISTRIBUTIONS

All students are directed that the lockers are given to them to keep their books in the school itself. Only test/homework related books and copies should be taken home. No student is allowed to take all the books and copies in bag which weighs more than 3 kg at any point of time.

LIBRARY/MEDIA CENTRE

The library is open during school hours. All borrowed items will be the responsibility of the user. Personal/additional reading, study sessions and facilities for the preparation of research project will be made available to the students on request. Any loss / damage of any library resource will have to be paid by the user. Only two books at a time will be issued for a time period of 15 days. A fine of Rs. 100/- per week will be charged for late return of books/ CD's/DVD's.

VISITORS

Visitors are not permitted on the campus during the school hours. However, in exceptional cases, permission may be granted. Parents are welcome to visit the campus on Fridays between 10:00 a.m to 12.00 noon with prior permission from the Principal/Dean Academic and Activities Planning/Admin Office. The authority who has given the permission will inform the reception about that particular person's details.

SCHOOL LOCKERS

Lockers are assigned to each student by the grade teachers so that students can keep their things safely. Hence responsibility for the loss of personal property lies with the student. School will not compensate for any such losses. Students who cause damage to their lockers will be charged. Any mechanical problem with the lockers should be reported to the teachers/respective Coordinators.

IDENTIFICATION CARDS

All students are provided ID cards which are to be worn when attending school and at any school programmes within or outside the campus. In case of loss or damage to the ID card, a new card would be issued at a cost of INR. 150. This is a **Mandatory** requirement for all the students.

TRANSPORTATION

Bus services are made available to the students. It is an optional facility provided by the school. The management will take all necessary precautions for the safety of the children availing the school transport but shall not be responsible for any unforeseen event.

The students are to be picked up by an authorized person carrying the necessary identification. In the absence of this, the child will be taken back to school. Parents are requested to take full responsibility for the collection of their child from the designated stop.

Incase of non payment of bus or school fees the conveyance facilities may be discontinued by the school at any time. Due to traffic or any other condition, the bus may be late which the parents can check through GPS App or contact school. Please note that the school reserves the right to re-route or withdraw bus services at its discretion.

Students are expected to remain seated on their seats while the bus is moving. Repeated misbehaviour or any act which may endanger lives or lead to damage to the vehicle will result in suspension of the bus service for that student. Clear rules are laid out for bus travel for the students. These are to be adhered to strictly to ensure safety all round.

SCHOOL INFIRMARY

When taking medication during school hours, the following requirements will have to be met

- The medical card of the child is mandatory to be deposited at school failing which the school may not be able to administer medicine in case of emergency to the child.
- The medicine must be prescribed by a registered physician.
- Parents must submit a written permission for such medication. Copy of the doctor's prescription should be attached.

If a student is unwell during the day, he/she may take a pass from the subject or grade teacher to go to the infirmary. The pass is to be returned to the teacher on return to class. The nurse records the visit of the student in the infirmary register. School must be informed of any allergies that a child may have.

A prolonged stay at the infirmary without prior permission amounts to truancy. If medical condition warrants (high fever, severe stomach ache, etc.) the parents would be asked to take their child home.

Students are administered basic first aid for common ailments and minor injuries. In case of any unforeseen emergency, the initial aid/support is provided as per the need and the parents of the concerned child will be informed immediately. The student will be taken to the hospital.

Students are usually up-to date on their immunization until they reach the age of 14. Please be sure to update their immunization records and provide the school with a copy. Allergies, if any, need to be intimated to the school.

Routine medical check-up of students are conducted through out the year by the school nurse.

The doctor makes regular visits to school.

STUDENT SERVICES - COUNSELLING AND GUIDANCE

Our Counselling and Guidance Services stress the individual uniqueness of students and is based on the belief that all students should be directed to a level of self-actualization. The scope of the services is preventive and proactive in focus and developmental in content and process. 'Developmental Counselling' and 'Crisis Intervention' are the two main components of the services.

The Guidance and Counselling Cell anticipates the challenges in the students' lives and assists them in gaining maturity. The underlying focus of the programme is to help students develop the skill, attitude and knowledge base they need for the success of their academic and personal endeavours.

Special support is provided to students who may experience learning difficulties so that their special educational needs (within the limits of mild and the moderate zone) are met.

At least 2 workshops on 'adolescence' are conducted for the students by paediatric experts to enable students to deal with their own physiological growth.

All teachers at ITM Global School are given basic primary training for the counselling and guidance.

Behaviour Management

Behaviour management techniques usually include encouragement, praise and positive reinforcement. Opportunities are provided to a student to gain self-control and reliance and to respond positively to others in a social setting. Acceptable and proper behaviour is described through stories so that students associate themselves with the characters and thus understand that their behaviour needs to improve. This does not destroy self-esteem and promotes acceptable social interaction with peers as well as adults. A positive proactive approach which includes prevention, redirection and praise is the preferred intervention model. Various **financial penalties** are also in place if the child does not respond to the above methods. The concept of **community service** is also in place in the school for students who continue to be in the defaulters list. **Temporary suspension** from school will be imposed on regular defaulters (more than 3 times) in case of a very serious misconduct, this may lead to **rustication** after proper enquiry is constituted.

Zero Tolerance Policy

1. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence from school, habitual late coming, leaving the school premises without permission, disobedience and any type of unruly and objectionable behaviour are considered to be grave acts of indiscipline on the part of a student which can lead to **his/her expulsion** from the school.
2. Using unfair means in a test or examination is a grave offence. A student who is found using unfair means will be **awarded zero in the subject** and will be issued a strict warning. Repetition of the same offence will result in **his/her expulsion** from the school.
3. Under no circumstances student will bring sharp and injury causing articles, crackers, fireworks, firearms and any other inflammable material in the school.
4. Students are not allowed to drive motorized vehicles such as cars, scooters and motorcycles within or outside the school. **If found strict action will be taken.**
5. Students are not permitted to carry mobile phones, smart watch and tabs to the school. If a student brings them to the school, it will be confiscated for a period of six months and **parent will have to come** to collect that.
6. Misbehaviour inside the school premises or in the school conveyance may also lead to **disciplinary action** against the concerned student.
7. Ragging, Bullying, Use of violence in any form, objectionable behaviour, use of abusive language, discourtesy and disrespect to the teachers and disobedience will also lead to **strict disciplinary action.**
8. Bunking classes or school is strictly prohibited.
9. Writing on shirt/uniform is a punishable offence.
10. If a student causing damage to the school property is identified, **he/she will be charged with a fine.**
11. Damaging, scribbling or tearing pages from library books, text books or exercise books will be **charged with a fine.**
12. Consumption of habit-forming eatables are strictly prohibited.
13. If any property is damaged, the **group/class can be held responsible**, even if the individual is not specified.

Preferred Code of Conduct

1. Students are expected to maintain a high standard of courtesy in their speech and in their interactions with teachers, colleagues and elders.
2. They must extend their courtesies to the support staff who maintain the school.
3. Students must reach the school at least 5 minutes before the first bell.
4. Changing classrooms between periods should be done in a quiet, orderly manner. Students should be habitually clean and always dressed smartly.
5. Students should take care of the school property as their own. Special care should be taken to ensure that the walls, furniture, computers and learning accessories are not subject to misuse. Any damage seen or done should be reported promptly to the grade Teacher/Incharges/respective Coordinator/Dean Academic and Activities Planning or the Principal immediately.
6. Shouting or whistling is not allowed in the school premises including hooting.
7. Students are advised not to carry valuables to the school.
8. Each student should take responsibility of his/her own belongings.
9. Students should have a deep and abiding respect for their work. Attentiveness in the class and regularity in homework and project work are of prime importance. Every student must participate in sports.
10. Personal hygiene and standards of cleanliness must be maintained at all costs. Hair must be well groomed. Dyeing or colouring of hair is not allowed.
11. All students are expected to converse in English within the school campus at all times.
12. Personal electronic devices of any kind are prohibited in the school premises.
13. Students should take pride in keeping the school environment clean.
14. ITMGS being an English medium school uses English as the working language within the premises of the school. The educators not only use English as the medium of instructions but also expect the learners to think and respond in the same language, hence, it becomes essential that the English language be introduced and developed Early Years onwards. The objective for this is to design a uniform methodology of addressing Learner's needs in the areas of:
 - Effective communication Skills
 - Building Confidence
 - Empowering research and knowledge enhancement skills
 - Receptive skills (Listening and reading)
 - Productive skills (speaking and writing)

Admissions

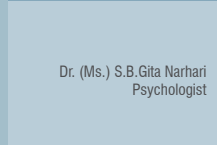

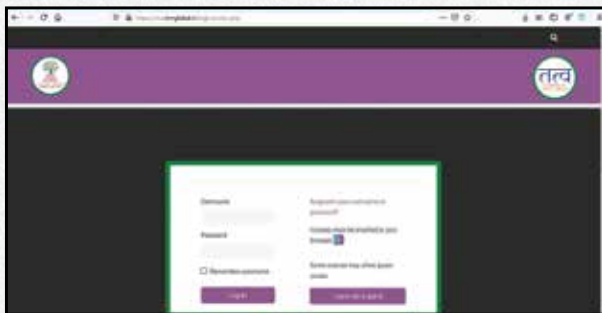
How to go on LMS (Tattva)

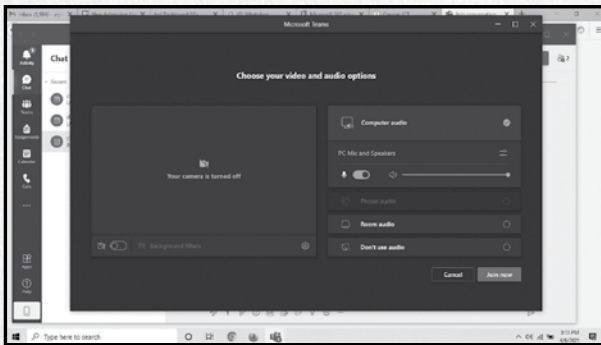

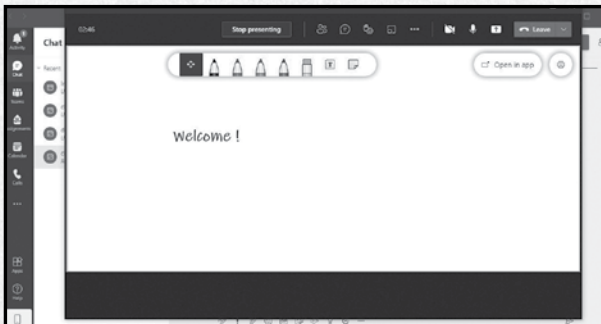

How to learn Efficiently

Today, everybody is a student. The expansion and updating of knowledge makes all of us life-long learners. Here are few tips for studying more effectively.

1. **Keep yourself fit both physically and temperamentally**

- Get sufficient sleep. Most of us need about seven hours sleep.
- Do vigorous exercise daily for at least an hour.
- Take time daily to do something that you genuinely enjoy such as painting, working with tools, music, poetry etc.

2. **Have a regular place for studying**

- Fix up a study table for yourself. Use a chair with a straight backrest. Only keep items which are being used on the table to avoid unnecessary overcrowding of table top.

- Leaves are granted only in case of emergencies. Leave application, **addressed to the Principal**, should reach the grade teacher a day before. In unavoidable circumstances, the application can be sent on the next day.
- The application should be signed by the parent or the guardian.
- Leave on medical grounds should be supported by an authentic medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner, all the reports taken and prescription of medicines given.
- Students suffering from infectious disease should not be attending classes.
- The attendance for the year should not be less than 75% of the total working days (for transfer cases, the attendance from previous school will be taken into consideration). Students failing to maintain this attendance would not be allowed to sit for the final examination, may not be promoted to the next grade.
- Regular notices are provided for shortage in attendance.
- Absence from school for twenty consecutive days (without approved leave) will result in removal of the student's name from the rolls. The student will have to apply for re-admission thereafter.
- **Grade 10th and 12th students require minimum 75% cumulative attendance from Grade 9 and 11 respectively in order to sit for the board examination. Admit cards will not be issued for less than 75% attendance.**

Examination Policy

Academic Year 2024–25

The Academic Session has been divided into two Terms.

The **First Term** is from April to September, and the **Second Term** is from October to March.

ASSESSMENTS 2024-25: PRE-PRIMARY

[CAMBRIDGE, Grades Nursery and KG & CBSE, Grades Nursery, LKG & UKG]

The Pre-Primary Section will have Formative Assessments (Orals/Skill Based) only and no Unit Tests. Only the Play Way method will be incorporated. **Yearly assessment based on the FA tools will be considered.** SA I and SA II Exams will be conducted for Pre-Primary.

ASSESSMENTS 2024-25: CAMBRIDGE, Grades I to XII

Grade I to VIII: Grades I to VIII will have four Formative Assessments (Including two Unit Tests) and two Summative Assessments.

Grade IX and XI: Grades IX and XI will have two Unit Tests and two Summative Assessments/Pre-Boards.

Grade X and XII: Grade X and XII will have one Unit Test and two Pre-Boards. Students appearing for the Board Examinations will have one Unit Test, one Pre-Board [and one Pre-Board [Entire Syllabus].

ASSESSMENTS 2024-25: CBSE Grades I to XII

Grade I-VIII: Grades I to VIII will have Periodic Test I, Periodic Test II along with the Half-Yearly Examination and the Annual Examination.

Grade IX: Grade IX will have 2 Periodic Tests along with the Half-Yearly Examination and the Annual Examination.

The Academic structure for Class IX is as per the Remodeled Structure of Assessment, as per CBSE guidelines.

Grade X: Grade X will have 2 Periodic Tests along with two Pre-Boards.

The Academic structure for Class X is as per the Remodeled Structure of Assessment, as per CBSE guidelines.

Grade XI: There will be two Periodic Tests (PT I & PT II) along with the Half-Yearly Examination and the Annual Examination.

Grade XII: There will be 1 Periodic Test (PT I and PT II) along with two Pre-Boards.

NOTE:

- Any Grade X and XII students not appearing for the **Two Pre-Boards will not be allowed to appear in their forthcoming CBSE / CAMBRIDGE BOARD EXAMINATION.**
- **No RE-EXAM** will be conducted for any student under any circumstances. The child will be marked absent if he/she misses any Unit Tests, First Semester and Second Semester Examination. They will be marked ABSENT and no average will be considered. Only Medical cases will be considered wherein the child may get exempted to appear for the same and the AVERAGE will be considered.

For this the following criteria's must be met:

- Medical Certificate must be produced from the Government Certified Medical Practitioner / Hospital with the registered ID.
- All the prescribed medicines and treatment prescriptions must be submitted.

For Dear Parents

Pre-primary/Primary School is the first step in your child's education. As a partner with parents in this responsibility, ITM Global School believes that the Pre Primary School should be an enjoyable and memorable experience for children.
