All our young musicians who took part in the competition, were well appreciated by the judges and each one's unique style made the competition a great success.




















ACTIVITIES





handrayaan-3 is the third mission in the Chandrayaan program, a series of lunar exploration missions developed by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO). On 14 July 2023, the mission consisted of a lunar lander named Vikram and a lunar rover named Pragyan, similar to those launched aboard Chandrayaan-2 in 2019.

LAUNCH

Chandrayaan-3 was launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre on 14 July 2023. The spacecraft entered lunar orbit on 5 August, and the lander touched down in the lunar south polar region on 23 August at 12:33 UTC, making India the fourth country to successfully land on the Moon, and the first to do so near the lunar south pole.

India, entering an Earth parking orbit with a perigee of 170 km (106 mi) and an apogee of 36,500 km (22,680 mi) Orbit. After a series of earth-bound maneuvers that placed Chandrayaan-3 in a trans-lunar injection orbit, ISRO performed a lunar-orbit insertion (LOI) on 5 August, successfully placing the Chandrayaan-3 spacecraft into an orbit around the Moon.

The LOI operation was carried out from the ISRO Telemetry, Tracking, and Command Network (ISTRAC) in Bengaluru. On 17 August, the Vikram lander separated from the propulsion module to begin the last phase of the mission.

LANDING

On 23 August 2023, as the lander approached the low point of its orbit, its four engines fired as a braking

maneuver at 30 kilometers (19 mi) above the Moon's surface. After 11.5 minutes, the lander was 7.2 km (4.5 miles) above the surface;

it maintained this altitude for about 10 seconds, then stabilized itself using eight smaller thrusters and rotated from a horizontal to a vertical position while continuing its descent.

FUNDING

In December 2019, ISRO requested the initial funding for the project, amounting to ₹75 crores (US\$9.4 million), out of which ₹60 crores (US\$7.5 million) would be for meeting expenditures towards machinery, equipment, and other capital expenditure, while the remaining ₹15 crores (US\$1.9 million) was sought for operating expenditure.

Amit Sharma, CEO of an ISRO vendor, said, "With local sourcing of equipment and design elements, we are able to reduce the price considerably".

Confirming the existence of the project, ISRO's former chairman K. Sivan stated that the estimated cost would be around ₹615 crore. (equivalent to ₹721 crore or US\$90 million in 2023)





The prime objective of ISRO/DOS is the development and application of space technology for various national needs. The greatest achievements of ISRO are Mangalyaan, Chandrayaan, etc.

The Chandrayaan-3 lander made

a successful soft landing on the surface of the Moon a little after 6 p.m. on Wednesday 23rd August 2023, making India the first country to reach close to the lunar south pole. India has also become the fourth nation in history to land on the lunar surface, after the United States, the erstwhile Soviet Union, and China.

As the nation celebrates the biggest breakthrough of the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), here is a look at the previous notable milestones of the space agency through three of its major programmers: satellites, launch vehicles, and planetary exploration.





$$2! = 2*1 = 2$$


$$1! = 1$$


