Visit to the Charminar

The Charminar (char – 4, minar – tower), 4 beautiful towers in Hyderabad, is the best known landmark built in 1591 by Sultan Mohammad QuliQutub Shah, after shifting his capital from Golkunda to Hyderabad. This architectural wonder is now a landmark of Hyderabad and tourists from all parts of the world visit Hyderabad to see the "Charminar".

It is a signature of Islamic architecture. It has a square base of 20 meter by 20 meter size and contains four arches, each of them opens in four streets. Each of the four grand towers are of the same height and if you want to reach to the top floor then there are 149 winding steps to be climbed.
